

The Kirklees Light Railway - Shepley-Shelley Station Link

This is a footpath route from Shepley Station on the Penistone Line to the Kirklees Light Railway at Shelley Station. This route is relatively wide, surfaced and is free from stiles and steps. It is possible to take a pushchair along this route but please be aware that in wet weather it may be muddy. At an average walking pace, this walk takes 25 minutes.

From Shepley Station walk along Station Road and turn left at Yew Tree Road. Go along Yew Tree Road to the junction with Abbey Road and cross the road close to the carved stone "Shepley" seat.

Walk along The Knowle - this section of the route follows the Kirklees Way. At the end of The Knowle, leave the highway and follow the surfaced track through the woodland (High Moor Lane). Follow this track until it joins Copley Lane. At this point, turn left, leaving the Kirklees Way behind. Walk down the hill and under the railway bridge that crosses the road. Just past the bridge, on the right side of the road take the track that leads up to Shelley Station and the Kirklees Light Railway.
